YOUTH REQUESTING A MENTOR:

- Ages 12-25
- Current or former foster youth
- Alumni students from Samueli Academy charter high school

WHAT WE ASK OF YOU:

- A commitment to the educational or life goals of your youth
- A commitment of six months or more
- Meet with your youth monthly
- Be at least 20 years old

HOW TO APPLY:

- Complete a mentor application and in-person interview
- Submit a copy of your driver's license and proof of auto insurance
- Pass background check, reference check and fingerprinting

COST:

• \$60 fingerprinting fee*
