Volunteers Needed

Orangewood Foundation offers meals Monday–Friday to former and current foster youth at the Orangewood Cafe. Volunteer Chefs are needed to provide meals for youth who utilize the Orangewood Resource Center or participate in our Independent Living Program - for assistance with finding housing, employment or help with any other basic needs.

What's for Lunch?

If you are interested in providing **lunch**, you would:

- Select a weekday to have lunch cooked onsite or delivered by noon.
- Provide all ingredients for the meal. Expect to feed about 15 youth.
- We recommend using up to 5 volunteer chefs. Groups larger than that can sign up for additional days to give everyone the opportunity to serve.
- Meals are set-up buffet style so that youth can serve themselves. Feel free to join them!

What's for Dinner?

If you are interested in providing **dinner**, you would:

- Select a designated night to have dinner cooked onsite or delivered by 5:30 pm.
- Provide all ingredients for the meal. Expect to feed about 60 youth.
- Serve the meal to our youth and join them for dinner.



About Orangewood Café

Orangewood Foundation has an onsite kitchen that includes two ovens, stoves, and microwaves. There are limited pots and pans, knives, and cooking utensils available to help make most basic meals. Meals are provided to support foster youth who are working towards independent living. Nearly 75% of the youth using the ORC come for help with food and groceries. The Orangewood Café Chefs help by serving an average of 180 warm meals a month.
