

ADVANCED STUDIES FUND (ASF) SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM GUIDELINES & SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

Orangewood Foundation Advanced Studies Fund (ASF) Scholarships provide financial assistance to former foster youth who are college graduates seeking assistance in pursuit of advanced studies. The intention of the Advanced Studies Scholarship is to serve as supplemental funding and not to cover the full cost of tuition, books, supplies, and living expenses. Submitting an application does not guarantee funding. You can contact Orangewood Foundation staff to assist you with questions by emailing: cetzold@orangewoodfoundation.org.

A. <u>APPLICATION PROCESS / FUNDING PERIOD</u>

Eligible students must complete the <u>Advanced Studies Fund Scholarship Application each</u> <u>year and must provide supporting documentation.</u> The annual funding period is aligned with our fiscal year, from July 1st to June 30th. Funding does not roll over into the next funding period. Funding for subsequent years in pursuit of advanced studies is not guaranteed with the award of initial support. Eligible students may request consideration for support from the Advanced Studies Fund in pursuit of graduate school, professional certification, or additional training required to obtain a career goal. All Advanced Studies Fund (ASF) Scholarship applications will be reviewed by the Advanced Studies Fund Committee (Orangewood Staff and ASF founders). Final funding decisions will be made by June 30th for the next school year. Applicants may be required to attend an interview at Orangewood Foundation offices in Santa Ana, CA. If travel to Orange County is not possible, a video conference call may be arranged.

Application process:

- Application submission period: March 1st May 1st
- Applicants Notified of Denial or Advancement to Interviews: Mid/Late May
- Applicant interviews (for selected students): Mid May Early June
- Applicant Notified of Acceptance or Denial: June

B. ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

- 1. For eligibility for Advanced Studies Fund scholarship consideration, student applicants:
 - a) Aged 18 through 38
 - b) Must have been declared a dependent of Orange County, CA, and placed in out-ofhome care.

<u>Or</u>

- c) Must have been declared a dependent child or ward in another jurisdiction and have a current association with Orangewood Foundation program services. *Cannot be a current full-time employee of Orangewood Foundation*. And
- d) Completed a bachelor's degree or certificate and enrolling in an advanced degree.

C. <u>SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS</u> - Your application packet must include: <u>New Advanced Studies Applicant (submitting a new program or brand new applicant)</u> Required:

- Completed Online Advanced Studies Application
- □ Transcripts for all Undergraduate work (unofficial transcripts accepted) and Proof of Graduation (Copy of Degree/Certificate)
- □ Proof of Enrollment/Class Schedule or College Acceptance Letter. Documents must include: Student's Name, School, and Term.
 - If acceptance has not been determined when application is submitted, acceptance needs to be confirmed by the interview date if selected to interview.
- □ Signed Scholarship Recipient Acknowledgement
- □ Signed Advanced Studies Fund Recipient Agreement
- Completed Budget Sheet
- One Current Letter of Recommendation
 - This must be within 6 months of application submission and specific to this scholarship opportunity.
- □ Applicant Essay
 - Must follow the question prompts within this packet. Must also be in essay format.
- □ Dependency Verification/Ward of the Court Letter
- Current Photograph
- □ Attend Interview with the Advanced Studies Committee (if invited to advance to interview)

D. SCHOLARSHIP FUNDING

<u>Please Note: Funding is approved on an individual basis, is subject to availability, and is</u> <u>not guaranteed.</u> Scholarship awards are generally \$2,000 and up per year based on applicant program. Max funding is \$10,000 a year. Funding amounts may change to reflect a student's change in academic status, units completed, and/or program eligibility. Advanced Studies Fund Scholarships are not categorical and amounts will be determined based on the number of requests, the identified needs, and the funds available. <u>Part-time students are</u> <u>eligible for funding.</u>

New Applicant (or New Program) Essay

Essay must be in the following format: double spaced, 12pt black font, 1-2 pages in length.

Essay Questions

- Why do you want to study/pursue your major?
- What are your academic and/or career goals?
- How will this scholarship help you?
- What are your greatest accomplishments?
- What are some extracurricular activities that you enjoy?

Concurrent (Continuing ASF Scholar) Applicant Essay

Essay must address the below questions.

Essay must be in the following format: double spaced, 12pt black font, 1-2 pages in length.

Essay Questions

- What kind of successes have you had in the past year?
- What have you learned about yourself this past year?
- How did the scholarship support you last year? How can it assist you this year?
- What are your greatest accomplishments?
- What are some extracurricular activities that you enjoy?
